


Map of Beijing




Badaling Section of the Great Wall

The Badaling Section of the Great Wall, ranking number one in the top 10 Chinese places of interest, is characterized by its splendour, elegance and magnificence.




Summer Palace

This is the best preserved tomb cluster in the world with the most emperors, making it the perfect destination for you to understand how ancient imperial tombs were constructed.




Fragrant Hills Park
