Enhanced Health and Safety Requirements for Covid-19

Columbia University follows New York State requirements for the size of permitted gatherings and requires all indoor and outdoor events to comply with University health policies. The following is a summary of these temporary guidelines:

- Follow the Health Compact guidance. Wear a face covering over your nose and mouth at all times, keep at least 6 feet distance between yourself and others whenever possible, and follow signage and guidance on use of spaces and buildings.
- No indoor or outdoor gatherings should exceed 50 persons, or if indoors, 50% of capacity, and are subject to local guidelines (summarized below).
- Event participation is restricted to CUID cardholders only and requires registration with WeWork or Global Centers' staff.
- If event organizers choose to serve food or beverages, both must be packaged for individual use and distribution must be planned to enable physical distance at all times. Event organizers must ensure that attendees are able to maintain sufficient distance throughout and avoid facing each other while removing their face coverings to eat or drink. If individuals bring their own food or beverages, event organizers must ensure that those eating or drinking are able to avoid facing others while their face coverings are removed, if unable to maintain physical distancing.
- Event organizers are responsible for ensuring that planning takes account of the Compact provisions and that event attendees adhere fully to the Compact's face covering and physical distance requirements.

Columbia-Designated WeWork Spaces

Beijing, Shanghai, Shenzhen	75% of full capacity.
Hong Kong	Public gatherings limited to 2 persons unless within the same household.
Singapore	Public gatherings limited to < 8 outside of the same household, with exception of reasonable excuses such as receiving education or care from government-body, school, after-school student care centre.
Seoul	Public gathering restrictions lifted until further notice.
London	It is against the law to meet socially with family or friends unless they are part of your household or support bubble. A support bubble is a support network which links two households.

Amman	Maximum 20 people allowed for any form of event or gathering.
Istanbul	Large gatherings are not allowed.
Mumbai	Large gatherings prohibited. Private gatherings limited to up to 50 people with 6 feet physical distance. Public gatherings to be avoided.
Nairobi	Maximum gathering size is 200 persons, whether inside or outside, but must wear face masks, sanitize, and keep social distancing of 1.5 meters.
Paris	No gatherings permitted with exception of funerals (30 persons max) and weddings (6 persons max)
Rio	50% of full capacity.
Santiago	Maximum 50 people indoors / 100 people outdoors.
Tunis	No events and gatherings until November 15.

Partnership Spaces

Athens	Gatherings are banned nationwide.
Tel Aviv	Gatherings are limited to up to 5 people indoors and up to 10 people outdoors. During permitted gatherings, distance of 2 meters will be maintained and masks will be worn.
