# Being Safe Together

## The Columbia Compact

Community agreement to follow guidelines to keep everyone safe



## Daily symptom check

ReopenCU smartphone app with green or red indicators



## COVID-19 testing

Convenient, rapid results



## Facility enhancement

New air filters, no recirculated air, frequent cleaning



## Physical distancing

Workspaces set up to provide safe degree of separation



## Contact tracing

For COVID-19 cases and contacts on campus



## Signage

Guidance for distancing, face covering, hand hygiene, elevator and room capacity



## PPE available

Cloth face mask and other personal protective equipment (PPE)



## Hand sanitizing stations

Facilitating high levels of hand hygiene



# Columbia University's "Reopening Plan"

- In early August, Columbia University developed a Reopening Plan for all campuses which includes our commitment to:
  - Facilities modifications and reduced density
  - Health screening
  - Testing and contact tracing
  - Hygiene
  - PPE
  - Communication
- Columbia has also committed to a mandatory face covering policy, transparency of facilities modifications, testing results, and many other matters
- Adherence to these policies is critical on and off campus for all Columbia affiliates

# Columbia University Compact

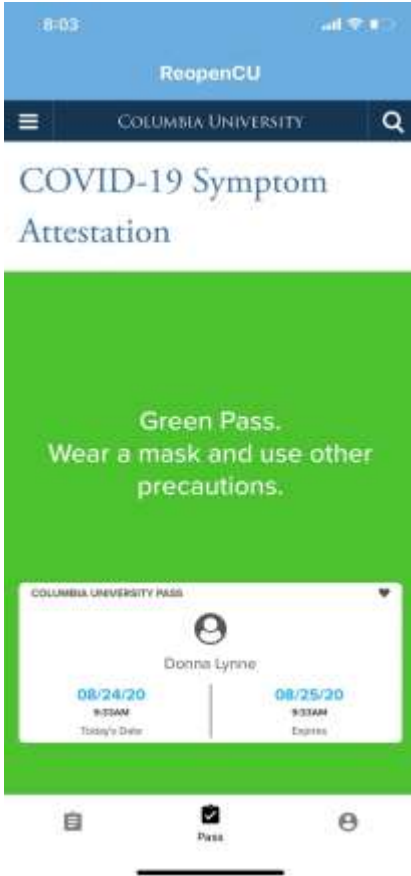
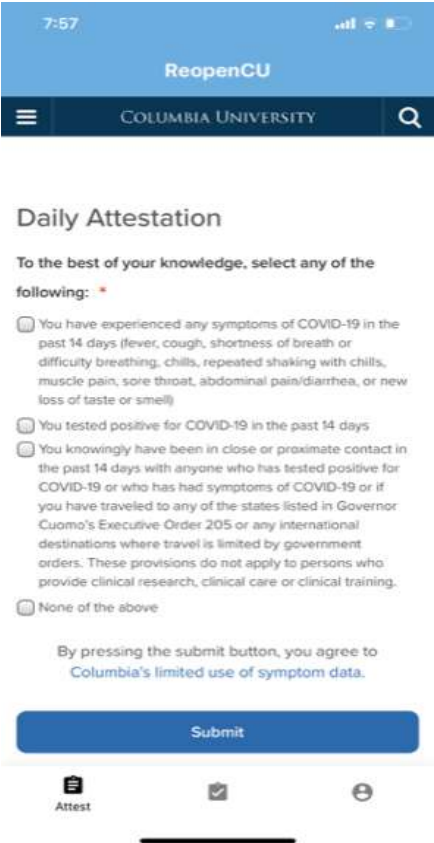
## **Columbia Community Health Compact:**

- A commitment that must be affirmed by all students, faculty, staff, and administrators before coming on campus
- Asks that each member of our community abides by the Compact to protect themselves but also to protect others, on and off campus
- Includes adherence to face covering, physical distancing, symptom checking, adherence to signage, participation in testing/tracing/quarantine/isolation
- Commits University to supporting all the needed accommodations

# Columbia University's Symptom Check

**Reopen CU** is a daily attestation all faculty, staff and students must complete to have access to University buildings; for non-University buildings similar email or written attestations are needed
